




HOW TO TAKE THE METRO (HSL)



Traveling between Otaniemi and Helsinki's city center is most convenient by metro. The Helsinki metro system has a single line running East-West. Due to summer renovations, the Central Railway metro station is currently closed, so the best stop for Helsinki city center is **Kamppi**.

We recommend downloading the **HSL app** for purchasing tickets, finding the best route, and getting updated service information. For travel between Otaniemi and the city center, you need a valid ticket for **zone AB**.

Ticket options include: Single tickets (2.95€), Multi-journey tickets (10 tickets for 26.55€), Day tickets (1 day for 9€, 2 days for 13.50€, and 3 days for 18€). These tickets are **valid on all public transport**, including metro, tram, bus, and some trains. The **last metro from Otaniemi** to the city center **departs at 23.29h**.



Metro route from Dipoli - Central Railway Station

- Walk ~10 mins to Aalto-yliopisto station (M) towards Kamppi direction
- Exit at Kamppi station (M)
- Walk ~10 mins to Helsinki Central Railway Station
